Thank you for choosing the Manhattan Plaza HD•T2. Please note the following was required to meet EU low power requirements:






1. RF Loophrough is disabled in standby by default

The ANT OUT socket at the back of the Plaza HD•T2 is disabled by default when in standby. This means that if you connect your TV to this socket and want to watch TV using its internal tuner, the Plaza HD•T2 must be turned on. To turn on RF Loophrough in Standby, please do the following at any time after the installation process is completed:

- Press  on the remote control to display the Setup menu
- Press  until the "System" section is highlighted
- Press  until "RF Loophrough in Standby" is highlighted
- Press  to turn it On. Each press of  will toggle it between On and Off.

2. Auto Standby is enabled by default

The Plaza HD•T2 will go into standby automatically if none of its remote or front panel buttons are pressed for 3 hours. To disable Auto Standby, please do the following at any time after the installation process is completed:

- Press  on the remote control to display the Setup menu
- Press  until the "Time" section is highlighted
- Press  until "Auto Standby" is highlighted
- Press  to turn it On. Each press of  will toggle it between On and Off.
