Manhattan T3•R v2.00 Release Notes (08/12/20)

New

- BritBox has arrived! Launch it from the Home Screen.
- Manual padding: Instead of relying on broadcaster signalling to start and stop recordings you can now add a customisable amount of padding to the start and end of all recordings. Go to: **Settings > Recording & Playback > Padding Options**. By default playback of recordings made with padding will start from the broadcaster's signalled start but you can change this to the recorded start.
- HDMI-CEC support: when you turn on your T3-R it can now turn on your TV and change it to the right input and go to standby when you put your TV in standby. You can also choose to put your TV and any other connected devices in standby when your T3-R goes to standby. Go to: **Settings > System > HDMI Options**.
- 3rd channel viewing and timeshifting: when recording on two channels you can now watch a 3rd channel. The available channels will depend on the two that are recording. If they are:
 - on the same multiplex then you can watch any channel
 - on two different multiplexes then you can watch any channel that's also on one of these two multiplexes
- Flexible reminders: While two recordings are in progress, reminders can be set for programmes on (available) third channels. Overlapping reminders can also now be set, e.g. a programme at 12:00 – 12:30, another at 12:05 – 12:30, another at 12:15 – 12:45, etc.

Improved

- If a software update is detected during first time install, you no longer have to enter your Wi-Fi password again after the update has been performed.
- When pressing the S/AD button, the availability of Subtitles and Audio Description status is now shown based on the broadcaster's signalling instead of the PMT. This can still be inaccurate if the broadcaster signals incorrectly, but in our testing it is more accurate than the PMT.
- Fast forward and rewind speeds are more accurate.

Resolved

- The T3-R could fail to turn on from standby and the LED would remain red.

- The T3-R could fail to record programmes and state that it was due to no signal even though the signal was ok.
- The T3-R could wake unexpectedly overnight.
- The T3-R could turn on from Sleep with no AV.
- After pressing the TEXT button on BBC channels when the internet was connected the system could stop responding to the directional or number buttons until the channel was changed.
- Audio Description could show as on but need to be turned off and on to work.
- The T3-R would show 'No Signal' for channels after performing a Smart Retune if the delivery system of their multiplex had changed.
- When adding a child profile to iPlayer, the T3-R would crash after entering the month of birth.
- When chase playing an active recording, the T3-R could stop playback and display "End of Playback" when the next programme started.
- In Wi-Fi networks with multiple access points, the T3-R would not always connect to the access point with the strongest signal
- While watching a live programme on a channel (e.g. BBC One HD) in full screen TV and using the Channel Browser to select a live programme on another channel (e.g. ITV HD) to record, the programme on the channel being watched (e.g. BBC One HD) would be recorded instead.
- The 'G' Guidance icon would be incorrectly shown instead of the 'W' Watershed icon.
- The BBC Red Button+ and green button restart service would not work after exiting playback of a recording to a BBC channel. Changing the channel or waiting for the next programme to start would resolve it.
