Manhattan T3•R v2.06 Release Notes (06/08/24)

Resolved

- A black screen could sometimes appear for 20-25s before apps or on-demand content would successfully open from Manhattan menus.
- Repeatedly switching and closing/opening BBC iPlayer, "U," or BBC HbbTV services could cause a memory leak, leading to system instability.
- ITVX issues:
 - Playback of ITVX content sometimes failed, displaying a "something went wrong" message.
 - The parental controls options for "Off" and "On" were truncated and not fully visible.
 - The "News" category appeared empty, preventing content browsing.
- S4C issues:
 - Signing in on the web did not provide the pairing code.
 - Pause and resume functions were not working correctly.
- BritBox has been discontinued, and the app has been removed from the Home Screen. Customers who wish to continue using BritBox should access it through ITVX.
- When playing recorded content and using the Left button on the D-Pad to skip back, playback could unexpectedly jump back to the initial starting point.

Improved

- Programme icons (e.g., Subtitles and HD icons) and attributes (e.g., programme start and end times) have been changed from blue to off-white for better visibility.
- The background has been enhanced to provide better contrast with other on-screen elements, such as buttons and programme cells.
- The Home Screen "Connect" banner shown when the T3•R is not connected to the internet has been updated.
